Pharmacy & Labs

Rutgers University Cancer Institute of New Jersey, New Brunswick, NJ



This project consisted of a 6,300 square foot renovation to the Rutgers University Cancer Institute of New Jersey. The project scope included a interior demolition and rebuild of all mechanicals and building finishes. The initiative spanned five months and the construction scope included new institutional laboratory clean rooms, non-sterile prep., pharmacy equipment and hoods, vaccine room, records room, anterooms, medical records and quality control rooms.









Villanova University Mendal Hall Lobby Renovation, Villanova, PA

Science & Labs

This project consisted of a fast track renovation to the Mendall Hall East Science Center. The project scope included a complete interior demolition and rebuild of all mechanicals and building finishes. The initiative spanned five months and the construction scope included new entry vestibule, lobby, gathering area, coffee bar, student study areas, and decorative science art feature wall.











Historic Dormitory Renovation

Rutgers University Willets Hall - New Brunswick, NJ



This project consisted of a 16,930 square foot renovation to the historic Willets Hall Dormitory. The project scope included a complete three floor interior demolition and rebuild of all mechanicals and building finishes. The initiative spanned eight months and the construction scope included new HVAC chiller and heat exchange equipment, first floor student common areas, upgraded electrical, new lavatories, gathering areas and dormitory rooms.









Recreation Center

Rider University Bart Luedeke Student Center - Ewing, NJ



This project consisted of a façade renovation to the campus student center at Bart Luedeke building. The project scope included a complete front façade demolition, new three story façade and canopy structure, lobby tie-in, decorative railing systems, new entrance plaza patio, and upgraded stormwater system. The initiative spanned five months and the construction scope gave the Rider University Campus a new and refreshed student center for the students and faculty.









Early Education School

Primrose Day Care - Cherry Hill, NJ

This project consisted of a ground-up early eduction for children ages 8 weeks to pre-kindergarden. The project scope included a single story façade education center including classrooms, recreational rooms, art rooms, lavatories, administrative offices, lunchroom and exterior playground. The project was constructed in six months and the construction scope gave the Cherry Hill Community a new childhood day care facility for learning and development.







Historic College Prep & Classroom

Moorestown Friends School - Hartman Hall

This project consisted of a 12,100 square foot renovation to the Hartman Hall Higher Education Building. The project scope included a two story façade demolition and rebuild, new class rooms, gathering areas, music room, upgraded electrical systems and geothermal mechanical HVAC equipment. The initiative spanned six months and the construction scope gave the Moorestown Friends School a new higher education center for students and faculty.









Science & Labs

George School - Newtown, PA

This project consisted of a 7,500 square foot renovation to the Science Laboratory Rooms at the George School. The project scope included a complete interior demolition and rebuild of all mechanicals and building finishes. The initiative spanned three months and the construction scope included renovation to the science laboratory rooms, hallways, stairwells, and faculty offices.











Historic Classrooms, Offices & Counselling

Villanova University, Vasey Hall - Villanova, PA

The project involved renovating and enhancing the infrastructure of a 20,250-square-foot historic (circa 1930) graduate studies building located on the campus.













Early Education School

The Learning Experience - Wilton, CT

This project consisted of a 11,210 square foot ground up early childhood development facility. The project scope included all 3,353 outdoor artificial turf playground, multi-purpose room, age appropriate classrooms, administrative offices, kitchen, lunchroom, and make believe play room.
